Businesses are growing outdoors

Rain or shine, day or night, outdoor spaces are becoming more important for consumers.

To make up for lost covers due to social distancing, the government relaxed laws during the pandemic, allowing restaurants, pubs and bars to serve food alfresco. New legislation plans to make this permanent. For operators with outdoor space, this represents an opportunity.

If you get your outdoor space right; you can serve more covers and extend dwell time - translating into increased spend per cover.

The frequency of visits for pub-goers is expected to return to pre-pandemic levels this year². And more than 1 in 4 of these pub goers (27%) expect space in outdoor areas³.

Creating Ambiance



Ambiance is key to more than 90% of consumers when choosing where to go out4.



Heat

Firepits and gas heaters can increase dwell time through providing warmth and intimacy. But if space or cost doesn't allow, blankets or hot water bottles are also an option.



Furniture

Low-slung sofas & coffee tables suit groups that are drinking or eating nibbles and small plates, while diners prefer a good-sized table & chair.



Soft Furnishings

Cushions and blankets add a pop of colour and encourage patrons to stay a little longer, order another drink or even a bite to eat.





Flowers and Foliage

Use plants to create zones and enhance mood. On table plants are an alternative to cut flowers that can be left outside.



Music

Introduce music outside on an outdoor speaker system or through a series of Bluetooth speakers.



Light

Lanterns can be used to light up the floor and point customers towards the bar and restaurant. Use on-table candles to create a magical effect and pull focus to the table.

Local and community pubs are seeing a resurgence in the UK, as **39% consumers expect to visit these pubs more this year**⁵ meaning the classic pub garden remains a cherished favourite.

Increase dwell time, spend and repeat custom by creating ambiance through candle lights. Lighting your outdoor candles at a set time each day gives staff the opportunity to check in with customers, or upsell another drink and some food or snacks.



As pavement dining rules relaxed, many UK venues adopted a European bistro-style approach, bringing their dining tables onto the street.

Health & Safety considerations

- Burn candles safely by making sure there is at least 10cm between candles.
- Always burn candles on a suitable holder or fire-resistant coaster.
- Extinguish candles using a candle snuffer to prevent smoking and ensure it's easy to light next time.
- Protect customers and candles when burning candles outdoors by using a candle holder designed for outdoor use.
- Draughts can lead to uneven burning, tunnelling, or running wax – causing hazards and unsightly drips. Prevent this by using high-quality outdoor candles with a long burn time to ensure fewer replacements.
